

Python for Beginners – Class 4 Homework

Ask the user to input ONE word. Then, output the word with dashes in between each letter.

Sample input/output 1:

Enter a word: watermelon
w-a-t-e-r-m-e-l-o-n

Sample input/output 2:

Enter a word: potato
p-o-t-a-t-o

Hint: Create a variable called **newWord** that will store the final word with the dashes. Using a FOR loop, loop through each index inside the word (use the length!!) and add the corresponding **letter** with a **dash** into the **newWord** variable (joining strings!!).

To loop through a string, refer to the “Looping Through a String” section on the class notes!
